



NOTICE for Bachelor's Degree Graduates  
Supervisor Selection for Final "Report"-Type Projects  
Sessions: March-April & July 2025

This notice is addressed to students who **intend to graduate during the following sessions:**

- **March-April 2025**
- **July 2025**

with the **"report"** option.

Students who wish to choose the **THESIS** option should not select a supervisor via the e-learning platform, but should contact the supervisor directly. All information can be found in the Bachelor's and Master's Thesis Guidelines.

To choose a supervisor, students should log in to the **e-learning platform:**

FINAL EXAMS for BACHELOR'S DEGREES – Dept. SA and DSE using the usual credentials for e-learning courses and click on:

**Select Supervisor - March-April 2025 session,**

Or

**Select Supervisor - July 2025 session**

Students will find a list of available professors with their respective availability (some professors may not have available slots for the session in question).



To assist students in choosing their thesis advisor, each faculty member has a link to their personal page with the relevant courses.

For the **March-April 2025** session, the platform for selecting the advisor will open on  
**November 7, 2024, at 9:00 AM.**

For the **July 2025** session, the platform for selecting the advisor will open on  
**March 25, 2025, at 9:00 AM.**

It is reminded that, as stated in the Final Degree Exam Regulations (Art. 1.2), "The advisor can be requested by students who have earned at least 150 ECTS credits." Students who have already earned 150 ECTS credits by the time the platform opens will automatically have access to select their advisor.

The list of students who have access to the platform will be updated at regular intervals to allow those who will earn 150 ECTS credits after the initial platform opening date to choose an advisor.

It is specified that those who have already selected an advisor for a previous graduation session and were unable to graduate will NOT need to repeat the procedure and will remain assigned to the advisor previously chosen.
